This year the Corry Vo Tech has 214 students enrolled- 165 students from the Corry Area High School and 52 students from the Union City High School.

The school offers training in eight career-oriented fields - Agriculture, Welding, Carpentry, Cosmetology, Health Assistant, Machine, Auto Mechanics, and Auto Body.

The eight courses offered are an extension of the home high school curriculum. Each student receives three credits per year for graduation, providing the student receives a passing grade. Each student receives a certificate of completion for his chosen vocational training.

The training consists of a half-day of theory and practical study over a three year period. During this time the student receives up-to-date vocational training which will qualify him for an entry-level job as a trained technician.

All students at the Vo-Tech have an opportunity to join two school organizations - VICA and FFA. Each organization provides an opportunity for students to learn leadership and citizenship skills.
