

Location

St. Paul's Senior Living Community is centrally located on more than 600 acres of beautiful rolling countryside in Northwestern Pennsylvania approximately one hour from Pittsburgh, Cleveland, and Erie. It's also conveniently located close to a variety of natural resources including several lakes, rivers, and State Parks.

History

The Pittsburgh Synod of the Reformed Church dedicated St. Paul Homes on December 10, 1867 in Butler, Pa., as a home to care for destitute orphaned children. In new facilities constructed through contributions from the Reformed Church congregations of Western Pennsylvania, the home was moved to Greenville, Pa. on February 24, 1908. It was there that health care services for the aging began in 1927. The children's home was closed in 1971 and total emphasis was placed on caring for the aging.

Independent Living at The Colony

- The Colony at St. Paul's is an independent living community where residents are free from the worries of home security, maintenance, and upkeep.
- Residents are investing in their future care and have access to higher levels of care.
- Home (appliances/HVAC) and property (snow and leaf removal, lawn mowing) maintenance is included in monthly fee.
- Residents lead active lifestyles with ample social, recreational, and volunteer opportunities on and off campus including beautiful outdoor spaces, day trips, fitness center and more.

Memory Care in Jones Serenity Circle & Lane

Specialized memory care services for **48 residents** with memory challenges, dementia, and dementia-related illnesses are provided in Jones Serenity Circle and Lane. All activities and programs are designed to stimulate mind and body.

Skilled Nursing Care at The Villas

At The Villas, we offer long-term care ordered by a physician and supervised by a RN or LPN .

The Villas features **neighborhoods** — smaller areas where residents reside — featuring

- Private and semi-private rooms
- Dining rooms
- Great rooms
- Kitchenettes
- Porches and patios

Outside of the neighborhood are additional **common areas**:

- Private dining room
- Salon

Short Stay Care in The Meadows

Short-term skilled nursing care, designed to return an individual to independence in their own home, includes wound care and IV medications as well as speech, occupational, and physical therapies.

All rooms are private, furnished, and include a television with cable service and a telephone.

Home Based Services with Without Walls

St. Paul's Without Walls was established in 2012 and offers qualified private duty home based assistance providing clients with the support they need to remain independent in their homes as long as possible.

Services are provided on an hourly fee for service basis and include:

Community Living

An alternative to personal care or a skilled nursing facility, our Community Living homes provide support services for up to three residents per home who qualify for the PA Waiver Program or who can pay privately.

The three-bedroom ranch-style homes in the Greenville community are staffed around the clock by Without Walls Care Partners.
