MA-51 Physical Form (see attached)

If have an Intellectual Disability diagnosis:

The box to qualify on the form are: ICF/MR which provides the following Provides health-related care to MR individuals. More care than custodial care but less than in a NF.

If have an Autism Diagnosis:

The box to qualify on the form are: ICF/ORC Care which provides the following Provides health-related care to ORC individuals. More care than custodial care but less than in a NF

The individual will also need the following to qualify for the ID services:

Vineland Adaptive Behavioral Scale

Vineland Adaptive Behavior Scales Third Edition is the leading instrument for supporting the diagnosis of intellectual and developmental disabilities.

Vineland-3 not only aids in diagnosis but provides valuable information for developing educational and treatment plans.

ABASIII

Adaptive Behavior Assessment System Third Edition (ABAS-3) gives a complete picture of adaptive skills across the lifespan. It is particularly useful for evaluating those with developmental delays, autism spectrum disorder, intellectual disability, learning disabilities, neuropsychological disorders, and sensory or physical impairments.
