# WHISKEY REBELLION FESTIVAL

ANNUALLY THE SECOND WEEKEND IN JULY IN DOWNTOWN WASHINGTON, PA

The Whiskey Rebellion Festival, hosted annually the second weekend in July in Downtown Washington, PA, is one of Washington County's largest free festivals and the only history festival that spotlights Washington County's history and heritage. The Festival commemorates the pivotal 1790s uprising against the federal whiskey tax, which occurred primarily right here in Washington County. This multi-day event is the primary summer attraction in Downtown Washington, featuring authentic historical reenactments with costumed actors portraying key figures of the rebellion in engaging street theater and educational presentations that bring history to life. The highlight of the weekend is a live tarring and feathering right on Main Street, transporting visitors back into the 1790's in Southwestern Pennsylvania.

In addition to its entertainment value, the Whiskey Rebellion Festival promotes heritage tourism by highlighting significant landmarks like the David Bradford House and Whiskey Rebellion Education and Visitor Center. A dedicated children's area ensures that families can enjoy interactive activities, games, and entertainment.

The Festival also features live music spanning a variety of genres, from folk and bluegrass to modern rock, showcasing local and national talent. Artisans, craft vendors, and food trucks add to the festive atmosphere, offering unique goods and delicious treats for all tastes. Last but not least, the Festival features some of the region's best whiskey, so you can eat, drink, and be rebellious.

The Whiskey Rebellion Festival is hosted by the Bradford House Historical Association, a 501C3 nonprofit.
