Physical abuse, or threats to commit abuse, are the most obvious forms of domestic violence and they are usually the actions that allow others to become aware of the problem. However, this type of abuse only makes up a small portion of the overall patterns of behavior that an abusive person will use to maintain power and control over their partner. These other behaviors exhibited by a person who is abusive are less easily identified, yet firmly establish a pattern of power and control in the relationship.
