And it does, because you are here.

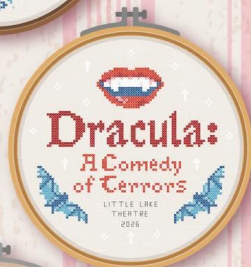
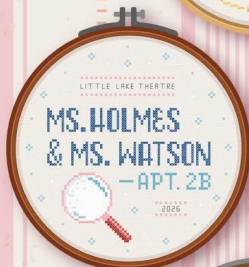
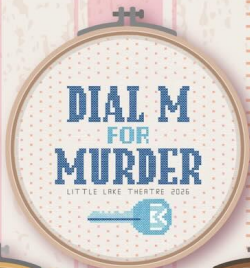

Alex Righetti (Costume Designer) has been designing costumes in the Pittsburgh Area for over a decade, working predominantly with local schools, as well as other locally based theater groups. Most recently he costumed Pittsburgh CLO's productions of Mel Brooks' Young Frankenstein and Who's Holiday! and the independently produced Repulsing the Monkey. He is part of the Pittsburgh CLO's Education Department where he works in an administrative capacity at the CLO Academy of Musical Theater.

Patti worked for 15 years with Pittsburgh Musical Theater as their Marketing & Development Manager while overseeing numerous educational programs reaching over 268 students ages 4-18, as well as maintaining the company's database. She was instrumental in formulating a successful \$3-million-dollar capital campaign, which resulted in Pittsburgh Musical Theater purchasing the building that has housed them for over 12 years. She has worked as a consultant to other nonprofits, assisting with grant writing, marketing, and implementing accessibility initiatives in the Pittsburgh area. Additional acting credits include work with Pittsburgh CLO, Drury Lane Theatre, Steppenwolf Theatre Garage Rep, Cape May Stage, Pittsburgh Playhouse REP, and other companies nationwide. He writes about theatre and leadership on Substack.

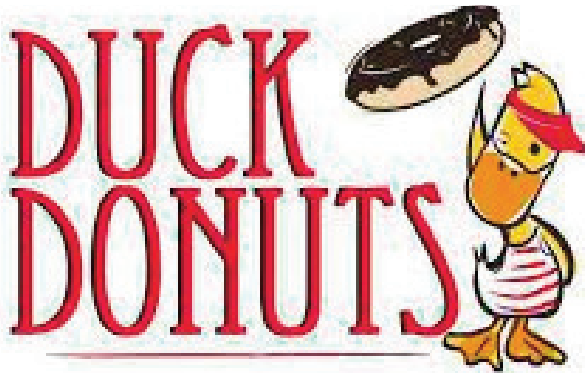
