#### A NOTE FROM THE DIRECTOR



She was instrumental in formulating a successful \$3-million-dollar capital campaign, which resulted in Pittsburgh Musical Theater purchasing the building that has housed them for over 12 years. She has worked as a consultant to other nonprofits, assisting with grant writing, marketing, and implementing accessibility initiatives in the Pittsburgh area. He has worked with renowned theater companies nationwide, including Pittsburgh Public Theater, City Theatre, Pittsburgh Civic Light Opera, Drury Lane Theatre, Steppenwolf Theatre Garage Rep, and Cape May Stage, among many others. 




