So here's to the next step. To a season full of bold choices, big feelings, and beautiful moments shared. Here's to saying yes to the adventure—whatever that looks like for you.

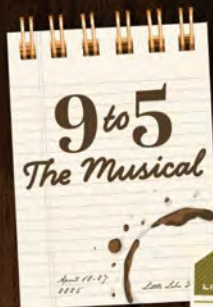
