52nd Annual Spring Meeting

The Auxiliary at St. Paul's gathered in Anderson Fellowship Hall at The Heritage on Saturday, May 10 for its 52nd Annual Spring Meeting.

Treasurer Reba Gizdic presented Chris Wright, President and CEO of St. Paul's, with a check for \$6,000 to complete payment for new outdoor furniture for the Bistro Patio.

The program portion of the meeting featured Ron Ashbaugh, Fitness Specialist at St. Paul's and Fun Committee member who presented: "The Good Times & Golden Years: The Fun Committee in Action." He also shared a slide show of photos covering the last 3 ½ years of activities spearheaded by the Fun Committee.

The Auxiliary Board presented the membership with a new project for the upcoming year—a wheelchair mover to assist residents in and out of the transportation vans (\$7,186). Following the vote, it was suggested that a demonstration of the new equipment be provided to volunteers after it is purchased.
