What is a charitable bequest?

A charitable bequest is simply a distribution from your estate to a charitable organization through your will. There are different kinds of bequests. For each, there is specific language to ensure your wishes are carried out as you planned.

TYPES OF BEQUESTS

- **Specific Bequest** - For gifting a certain dollar amount, appreciated security or other asset to St. Paul's.

Sample Language:

I bequeath the sum of \$__ (or __% of my estate) to St. Paul Homes, a not-for-profit organization, Tax ID# 25-0773080, located at 339 E. Jamestown Rd. in Greenville, PA, 16125.

- **Residuary Bequest** - For gifting the remaining portion of your estate to St. Paul's after specific amounts are distributed to other beneficiaries.

Sample Language

I devise and bequeath the residue and remainder of my estate to St. Paul Homes, a not-for-profit organization, Tax ID# 25-0773080, located at 339 E. Jamestown Rd. in Greenville, PA, 16125.

- **Contingent Bequest** - For gifting your estate to St. Paul's if your primary heir(s) pass away before you.

Sample Language

In the event that (insert name) does not survive me, I bequeath St. Paul Homes, a not-for-profit organization, Tax ID# 25-0773080, located at 339 E. Jamestown Rd. in Greenville, PA, 16125 all (or \$ amount or %) of my estate.
