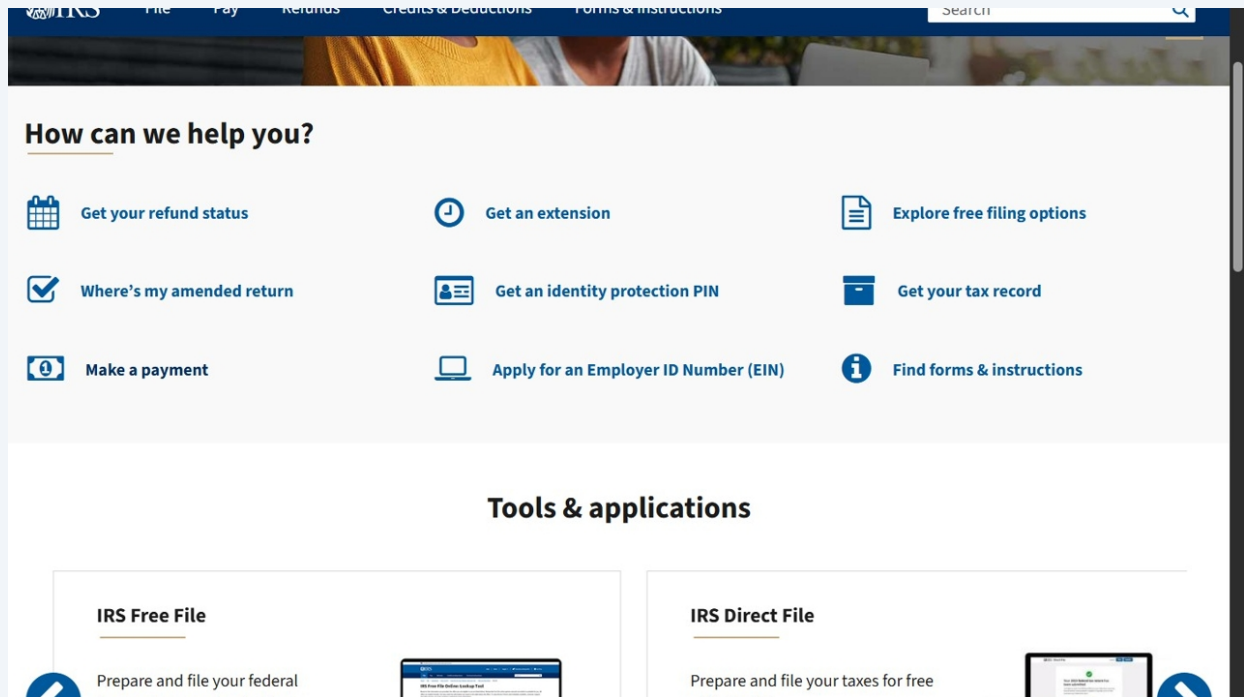
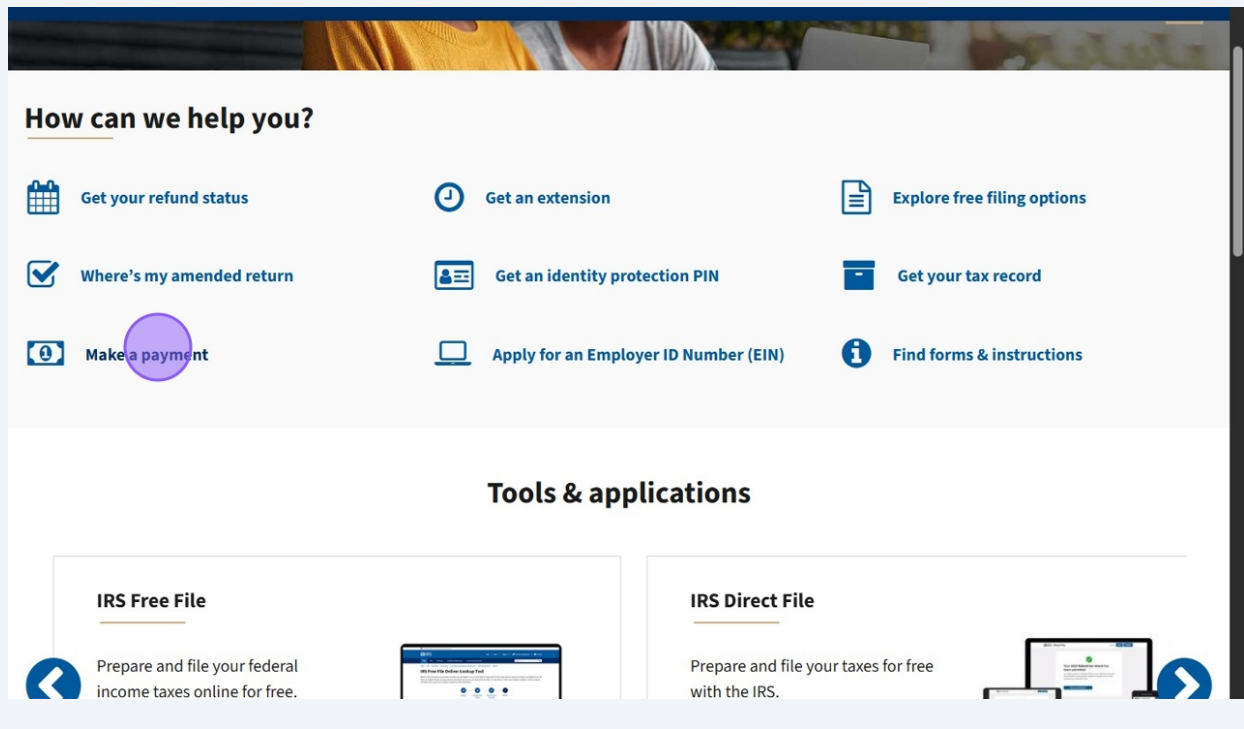


How to Make a Payment on IRS Direct Pay

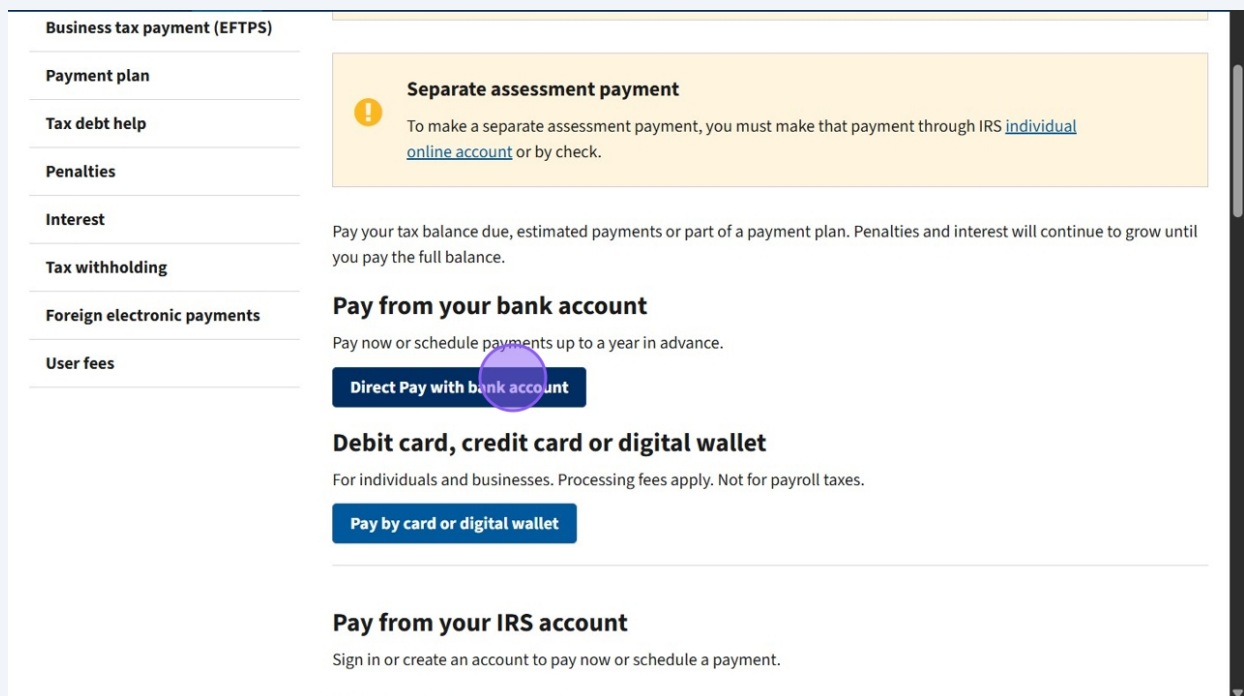
1 Navigate to <https://www.irs.gov/>


