

#### STATE HOUSE LICENSURE & RENOVATIONS

As of August 28<sup>th</sup>, all four Resurrection Power houses are licensed with the PA Department of Drug and Alcohol. It has been a long process, but we are thrilled to accomplish this goal!

We opened our new Genesis House for Women in the spring and began the renovation of the Trinity House for Men. Our men will move into the house around September 20<sup>th</sup>.

We have also begun the renovation of our Serenity House for Men and hope to have the work completed around the beginning of 2026.

We have made the decision to sell our Providence House to an amazing organization that will renovate and turn the house into a % house to further help Rez Power and other men in the community.

2026 will hopefully allow us to renovate our last house and complete landscaping at all houses.



Resurrection Power was invited to apply and was chosen for the Hillman Family Foundation for a program called the Hillman Capitalization Initiative. This will be a 3-year investment involving 15 organizations over four counties. The Hillman Foundation will work with us to build financial resilience, sustainability, and expand our impact. Praise God, as this is a huge blessing!

The Hillman Capitalization Initiative will be a large time commitment. With this commitment, the Board of Directors and the Executive Director made the decision to grow our team. This will enable us to collaborate with the Hillman Foundation without disrupting the care, love, and support provided to our residents, treatment facilities, and donors/supporters.

Marti Milan joined the team on February 25, 2025, as a part-time executive assistant.

Dana Van Atta joined the team on February 3, 2025, as a part-time Certified Recovery Specialist. She became a full-time Program Coordinator on August 6, 2025. Dana will be responsible for the programming and resident side of Rez.
