PROFILES IN LEADERSHIP: THE GOOD, THE BAD, & THE UGLY | DATES: Mon/Wed - Sept 14, 16, 21, 23

COST: \$20 (If taking both History/Government courses, cost is \$30 total.)

Students will examine both celebrated and obscure American leaders, discovering how character, integrity, courage, and decision-making influenced their successes, failures, and lasting legacies. This is the third of five courses with a focus on history, civics, and government over the next year, that will culminate with a historical trip to Washington, D.C. in the Spring of 2027. Students will be selected for this experience based on their participation in this, previous, and future historical courses

INTRODUCTION TO AVIATION | DATES: Tue/Thur - Sept 15, 17, 22, 24, 29, Oct 1, 6, 8 | **COST:** \$30

LOCATION: Fundamentals Flight Training (1603 Asbury Road)

Have you ever wondered what it takes to become a pilot or work in the aviation industry? This hands-on course, offered in partnership with Fundamentals Flight Training, gives students the opportunity to explore aviation through simulators, airport experiences, and interactive activities, while learning about exciting career pathways in aerospace and aviation.

Explore the exciting world of 3D printing by learning how printers work, creating digital models, and producing real objects. Working in teams, students will research market trends, develop or select a marketable product, and pitch their idea "Shark Tank" style to convince judges why their item should be manufactured and sold by Urban University to help fund their history trip to Washington, D.C.
