## ARMC Academy - Now Accepting Applications for 2025

ARMC Academy is a summer internship designed for high school students interested in healthcare careers. Eligible students are welcomed into the hospital for a professional, practical learning experience. Students are placed in a variety of clinical settings, rotate assignments at least once during the program, have opportunities for short one-day placements, and may participate in lunch-and-learn presentations that provide a well-rounded perspective of both clinical and nonclinical departments of the healthcare system. The culmination of the experience is a commencement program during which students give a presentation on their experiences and are awarded with their scholarship.

The ARMC Academy program is administered by ARMC Foundation in support of ARMC. Since its inception, over 120 local students have participated in ARMC Academy, and many have returned to ARMC as caregivers. Applications are available through school guidance counselors and on the ARMC Foundation website.

On Monday, February 17, long-time surgical waiting volunteer Beverly Applebee will celebrate her 90th birthday!


Bev began volunteering at ARMC following the death of her husband, Don in 2014 and currently volunteers two days a week in surgical waiting.
