Catholic Foundation of Northwest Pennsylvania Announces 2025 Grant Awards Totaling \$267,553

The Catholic Foundation of Northwest Pennsylvania is pleased to announce that 46 grants totaling **\$267,553** were awarded to support 44 projects during its 2025 grant cycles. Funded by the Foundation's *Education Endowment*, *Faith Formation Endowment*, and *Catholic Social Ministry Endowment* as well as endowments established by individuals to carry out their charitable goals, these grants support a wide range of projects and needs and will have impact throughout the thirteen counties of the Diocese of Erie.

The Catholic Foundation attracts, professionally manages, and invests donor gifts. Through the stewardship and growth of these funds, grants are made to support the current and long-term financial needs of parishes, schools, charities, and other ministries in northwest Pennsylvania.

2025 Spring Grant Awards

Diocese of Erie Office of Faith Formation received a **\$1,300** *Bishop Donald W. Trautman 'Feed My Sheep' Grant* to create a faith formation program for youth with disabilities.

DuBois Central Catholic School (DuBois, PA) received a **\$5,000** *Education Grant* to support the purchase of materials and training for project-based learning in STEM, science, design, and coding classes.

Erie Catholic School System (Erie, PA) received a **\$5,000** *Education Grant* to support the development of middle school elective curricula.

Gannon University (Erie, PA) received a **\$15,250** *Education Grant* to support college student attendance at FOCUS SEEK26 Conference.

2025 Catholic Social Ministry Grant Awards

Benedictine Sisters of Erie (Erie, PA): \$5,000 Catholic Social Ministry Grant to support the Benedictine Peacemakers Program, a monastic immersion experience for women ages 22-30.

Catholic Charities Counseling and Adoption Services (Erie, PA): \$15,000 Catholic Social Ministry Grant to provide emergency financial assistance and underwrite uninsured and underinsured counseling clients.

Prince of Peace Center (Farrell, PA): \$5,400 Robert M. Gallivan Charitable Grant to support purchase of a point-of-sale system for the center's thrift store and boutique, and a **\$4,500 Robert M. Gallivan Charitable Grant** to support Q Academy, which will provide mentoring and educational support to male youth in grades 7-12 without a father figure.

Saint Elizabeth Center (Oil City, PA): \$15,000 Catholic Social Ministry Grant to provide financial assistance to their clients to prevent or reestablish utility shut offs or evictions.

Saint Joseph Parish/Bread of Life Community (Erie, PA): \$15,000 Catholic Social Ministry Grant to update and expand the space for the Saint Clare's Clothing Store, the parish's free clothes store.

Saint Patrick's Haven (Erie, PA): \$9,000 Catholic Social Ministry Grant to refurbish the storage area for guests' belongings and essential health and hygiene supplies.

Saint Thomas the Apostle Parish (Corry, PA): \$9,700 Catholic Social Ministry Grant to purchase essential meal containers and packaging supplies for Hearts & Hands: Cooking with Compassion, the parish's community meal outreach program.

2025 Fall Education Grant Awards

Diocese of Erie Communications Office received a **\$5,000 Education Grant** to support attendance at the Catholic Media Conference and new technology for evangelization efforts.

Diocese of Erie Office for Women Religious received a **\$1,000 Education Grant** to support the Catholic Rural Ministry in Oil City. This grant will assist in the purchase of materials for the sisters to provide spiritual enrichment programs and activities.

Diocese of Erie Office of Faith Formation received a **\$13,800 Education Grant** to support Amazing Parish Leadership Summit participation and coaching for diocesan and parish teams.
